To improve their chances of success, hackers are now searching out the organisations that are likely to be less aware of the cyber threat: those that have not been attacked yet, such as smaller companies or those with a lower public profile. HR has a vital role to play in educating employees about the impact their attitudes and behaviour have on the organisation's security.

This includes HR team a chance to intervene, including taking steps to increase monitoring and deter them. Managing an employee's exit with a view to security is also one of the most critical of all the contributions the HR team can make.
